

CINDY BRASFIELD

A large part of Cindy's equine career has centered around a mammoth jack, TJC Clyde. Cindy owned, trained, and showed TJC Clyde to a National Championship Driving and World Championship Western Pleasure Titles as well as many other honors. TJC Clyde was inducted into the North American Saddle Mule Association (NASMA) Hall of Fame and was the leading points sire of show mules in the nation in 2003, 2004, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2014.

Cindy also trained and competed on a mule, Arco Rudy for many years in the 50 mile division of American Endurance Ride Conference (AERC). In 2001, after qualifying for the National Finals Championship, Rudy and she raced against 136 horses over grueling, mostly vertical terrain for 50 miles, beating all the horses to win the coveted National Champion Best Conditioned Award.

Cindy trained her first mustang in 1978, before training mustangs was 'cool'. Since then she has trained, adopted, or rehomed over two dozen BLM burros and mustangs. She also trained and competed in Extreme Mustang Makeovers for 5 consecutive years.
